Ryan Miller is 12-8-1 all-time against PHI with a 2.88 GAA... **Jason Pominville** leads all Sabres with 10 goals and 20 points in 22 career games against PHI.

KILLING TIME

After killing off five of six penalties Saturday vs. FLA, Buffalo's penalty kill ranked second in the league at 91.9% (36-for-39) entering play Tuesday. The team ended the 2010-11 season by going 48-for-52 (92.3%) on the kill in their last 17 games to finish 13th in the league at 83.0%. **Ryan Miller** has a save percentage of .917 while shorthanded this season.

60 MINUTES

Through 10 games, the Sabres are the only team in the NHL yet to play an overtime period. The current streak is the longest the team has gone without overtime to start the season since 2003-04, when they went 11 games before first needing extra time in their 12th game of the season (1-1 tie at OTT, 11/1/03). The longest such streak to start a season in franchise history is 12 games (1996-97).

QUICK STARTERS

Thomas Vanek's 15 points (8+7) in 10 games are the second-best total by a Sabre through 10 games since Pat LaFontaine scored 29 in the first 10 games of the 1992-93 season (Maxim Afinogenov had 16 points in the first 10 games of 2006-07). Like Vanek, **Jason Pominville** is also off to the best start of his career, notching 14 points (5+9) in the first 10 games. Both players entered play Tuesday ranked in the top five in NHL scoring.

MR. CONSISTENT

Vanek has scored 36 points (17+19) in his last 27 regular season games, dating back to Mar. 5. Since then, he has not gone more than one game without recording a point. Vanek's 17 goals during that stretch trail only Corey Perry's total (23); his 36 points rank fourth in points behind Daniel Sedin, Jason Spezza and Perry.

HOME COOKING

Tonight's game is the fourth in a five-game home stretch ending with a matchup with Calgary on Friday; the Sabres are 1-2-0 so far. The home stand is the first of two five-game stints at home this season, the longest such stretches for the team in 2011-12. The next one will take place between Dec. 7 vs. PHI and Dec. 16 vs. TOR.

THE IRON MAN

Brad Boyes enters tonight's game as the team's leader in consecutive games played (502). Boyes has the NHL's third-longest active ironman streak, and has never missed a game due to injury in his NHL career. He trails only Calgary's Jay Bouwmeester and Vancouver's Henrik Sedin.

LINDY'S LONGEVITY

Since **Lindy Ruff** was named Buffalo's head coach on July 21, 1997, there have been 163 coaching changes in the NHL. After Tony LaRussa announced his retirement on Monday, Ruff became the second-longest tenured coach in the four major professional sports leagues. Only Gregg Popovich, who began coaching the San Antonio Spurs in 1996, has been head coach of his team longer than Ruff.

THE ARBOUR CLUB

Lindy Ruff has 532 wins as head coach of the Sabres, second-most by a head coach with a single franchise, trailing only Al Arbour (740). Ruff has more wins than any other coach with his first NHL team.

Philadelphia Flyers: Head Coach and Player Bios

Head Coach: Peter Laviolette

Peter Laviolette was named the 17th head coach in Flyers history on Dec. 4, 2009. Over the final 57 games of the 2009-10 season, Laviolette coached the Flyers to a 28-24-5 record. He then led the club on a remarkable playoff run, picking up series wins over New Jersey (4-1), Boston (4-3) and Montreal (4-1) on the way to the eighth Stanley Cup Final appearance in Flyers history.

Laviolette previously spent parts of five seasons as head coach of the Carolina Hurricanes (2003-04 to 2008-09), where he compiled a 167-122-34 record in 323 games. In 2005-06, Laviolette led Carolina to the only Stanley Cup championship in franchise history, which culminated with a 3-1 win over Edmonton in Game 7 of the Stanley Cup Final on June 19, 2006. The Hurricanes won the Southeast Division that year with a record of 52-22-8, and set franchise records for wins and points (112) in a single season. Laviolette was named a finalist for the Jack Adams Trophy as NHL Coach of the Year that season.
